(SIR JOHN'S LANE AREA, LOCKLEAZE WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding in **Cottisford Road, Parkside Gardens, South Hayes** and that length of **Sir John's Lane** from Heyford Avenue to South Hayes between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.10 a.m. and the hours of 2.50 p.m. and 3.35 p.m. on Monday to Friday.

The closures would operate during Glenfrome Primary School term days only and exemption would be provided for pedal cycles, blue badge holders, for specified/statutory purposes and for permit holders. Permits would be issued at the discretion of the Council.
