The Dean Field Studies Centre has been running Outdoor Learning Courses residentially and as day visits for over 40 years. We also deliver courses in schools.

We will run a team building event for a group of peer mentors in the morning and provide them with the training to help facilitate an afternoon outdoor team problem solving event to another group of up to 108 students at a time.

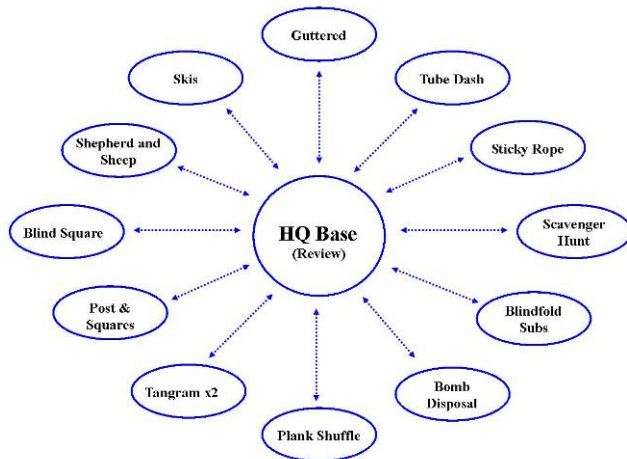
The structure of the day is equally suited to large Yr 7 Induction Days as it is to a single primary school class for curriculum enrichment (see "Numbers & Costs").

School staff are encouraged to take an observation role where they can learn the 'tricks of the trade' and be in a position to run similar events in the future or cascade this to other staff. We will provide lesson plans and resource lists and further 'after sales' advice if they wish to take advantage of this service.

Learning Outcomes for Peer Mentors and Participating Students include the following:

- Developing key skills: communication, problem solving, leadership and teamwork
- Developing a greater awareness and understanding of team skills and qualities
- Personal development of pupils – e.g. increased perseverance and commitment
- Experience of achieving success and responsibility
- Developing a positive attitude to new challenges
- Contribution to improving educational attainment through an increased motivation and appetite for learning

## Numbers & Costs:



### Primary Schools:

Min of 6 & max of 12 Yr 6's trained in morning as Peer Mentors to deliver and facilitate reviewing of problem solving challenges to >36 Yr 5/6 in afternoon.  
NB Minimum of 2 school staff to take a floating role in the afternoon session.

Cost = £395

NB For larger primary schools the whole project can be doubled. i.e. up to 24 Peer Mentors & 72 Yr 5/6 in afternoon.

Cost = £695



### Secondary Schools

Training for up to 36 Yr 12-13 Peer Mentors & 108 Yr 7's.

Cost = £1,185

Training for up to 36 Yr 12-13 Peer Mentors & 144 Yr 7's.

Cost = £1,495

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
