

Hourly pay gap


In this organisation, minority ethnic staff earn 90p for every £1 that white colleagues earn when comparing median hourly pay. Their median hourly pay is 10.3% lower than their white colleagues.



When comparing mean (average) hourly pay, minority ethnic mean hourly pay is 6.2% lower than their colleagues. <u>About median and mean</u>

The percentage of minority ethnic people in each pay quartile

In this organisation, minority ethnic people occupy 10% of the highest paid jobs and 18% of the lowest paid jobs.
