

Criteria for inclusion of species on the Bristol BAP Priority Species List

- 1) Species on the UKBAP List that are found in Bristol. NB - species for which Bristol has occasional records, but is of little significance e.g. vagrants, have been excluded from the Bristol BAP List
- 2) Species that are found in nationally or internationally important concentrations in Bristol
- 3) Species whose local declines meet the criteria used at national level for inclusion on the national BAP List
- 4) Species that are strongly associated with buildings, for which development control could therefore be very significant, which the steering group have reason to believe would meet criterion 3, but for which robust data is lacking.
