

Permanent Exclusion (PEX) Process

School issues PEX (and notifies LA)

Where does the child go?

Permanent exclusion process

School provides education for first 5 days (usually send work home). Child's resident local authority provides education from day 6 (full-time setting or alternative learning provision package).

Governors' meeting held (15 school days from date of PEX)

Child attends Full-time / Alternative Learning Provision (ALP) setting(s).

PEX is **UPHELD** *

PEX is **OVERTURNED**

Child stays in full-time / ALP setting whilst EHCP is finalised and consults for new school place are sent out.

Referral to Fair Access Panel (FAP). School place allocated.

Child remains the responsibility of the school. School to work with parent and child to readmit or support through other means.

* Parent *may* request independent review panel (IRP). See page on IRP.

Child goes on new school roll.
