

CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL

(BARNSTAPLE ROAD, FILWOOD WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 202-

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:-

Commencement and citation

1. This order shall come into operation on ----- and may be cited as the City Council of Bristol (Barnstaple Road, Filwood Ward, City of Bristol) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 202-.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order:-

“**enactment**” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

“**pedal cycle**” means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle that is not treated as a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act of 1984.

- (2) Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or having affect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Prohibition of Driving

2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of road identified as **Prohibition of Driving (Except cycles)** in plan **TRO-24-012-03** annexed hereto.

Exemption

3. Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the length of road referred to therein.

Order to be Revoked

4. The County Council of Avon (Filwood Broadway, Knowle, City of Bristol) (Southern Zone) (One Way Traffic) Order 1994 is hereby revoked.

5. The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by any other enactment.
