

Allocation Statement for Elmlea Infant School - September 2025

As Elmlea Infant School was oversubscribed, the criteria stated in their published admissions policy available on the school and Local Authority websites have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

250 on-time applications (126 x 1st preferences, 82 x 2nd preferences, 42 x 3rd preferences) have been received for Elmlea Infant School, which has an Admission Number of 90.

No places are required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 90 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0 places)
2. Those children with siblings already at Elmlea Infant School or Elmlea Junior School and who will still be there in September 2025. (41 places)
3. Those children living closest to Elmlea Infant School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (49 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.095km

Infant class size prejudice appeals - effects of infant class size legislation.

Appeals for Elmlea Infant School will be heard based on infant class size prejudice as the school will have three Reception classes each containing 30 pupils.

Places have been offered to the following children:

1. Children in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously in Care but immediately after being in Care became subject to an adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order. (0)
2. Those children with siblings already at Elmlea Infant School or Elmlea Junior School and who will still be there in September 2025. (0)
3. Those children living closest to Elmlea Infant School as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school. (9 places) The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.186km
